Who needs Ocean Cargo protection?

Just about every entity who imports or exports raw materials, semi finished goods, finished goods or sells a portion of finished products abroad needs ocean cargo insurance. This list includes but is not limited to, manufacturers, retailers and import and export traders.

In addition if you are a logistics provider, customhouse broker, transportation company, or in any way handle cargo while in your care, custody and control, you have an added liability exposure that needs protection.

What's covered?

The ocean cargo policy protects any international shipment through each leg of their voyage, from the point of departure from the seller's warehouse to arrival at the consignee's warehouse. Whether the transit is on land, sea or air, coverage is continuous and includes, if needed, related warehousing anywhere in the world, and domestic transit within the US.

The basic ocean cargo policy is 'All-Risk' providing coverage for physical damage to insured goods from any external cause. It is a pure international transit policy covering the goods while in transit from *point A to point B*. The basic international transit policy can be extended to cover related storage exposure, before the commencement of transit, while in transit short of final destination, or after it has arrived at the final destination. It can also be extended to cover any subsequent inland transit either foreign or domestic, exhibition exposures, processing and installation risks.

For logistics providers and non-vessel owner common carriers (NVOCCs) we provide shippers interest coverage, legal liability coverage, and errors and omissions coverage.
